## Important things to note

- Express students will take 7 or 8 subjects.

Note:
Students who are officially exempted from Mother Tongue may take 6-7 subjects.

- You are advised to select the combinations with 8 subjects only if you are confident that you can manage the demands for all 8 subjects.
- 8 subjects combinations are:
$\checkmark$ Triple Pure Sciences
$\checkmark$ Double Pure Sciences (Phy \& Chem) with Core Humanity
$\checkmark$ Double Pure Sciences (Phy \& Chem) with Course Work

## Important things to note

- If you miss your preferred combination's criteria by a few marks, you can still select it as your first choice. However, your other choices MUST be combinations you are eligible for.
- Being eligible for a combination does not guarantee that you will get the combination. It is also dependent on your choice and the vacancies in each subject combination.

## Important things to note

- If you meet the minimum criteria to do pure Sciences, you can use the first four choices for Pure Science combinations (3E1 \& 3E2). Your 5th choice must be a Combined Science combination (3E3 or 3E4). In the event that the Pure Sciences vacancies are filled up, we will know your preferred choice for combined Science combinations.
- Minimum enrolment to open a class for a specific subject: 15 students.
